<b>Description of Service</b>	The Dementia Home Monitoring Program is coordinated by a Registered Nurse who assesses and develops a care plan for the client in consultation with the client/carer and/or family. Community Support workers and/or the Coordinator visit clients to provide practical in home support including meal and medication supervision, assistance with personal care, shopping, transport to appointments (e.g. GPs, hairdressers) and supervised social outings. The program operates in conjunction with other community support services e.g. Home Care, Neighbour Aid, Meals on Wheels, Dementia Day Care etc. The coordinator also provides support, dementia care information, advice and education for family carers of client's on the program.
<b>Who to refer?</b>	A resident of the Sutherland Shire with a dementing illness who requires support to remain living at home.
<b>How to refer?</b>	1. Phone or 2. Fax a Southcare referral form
<b>Referral criteria</b>	Residents of the Sutherland Shire (or residing with) who have a diagnosed dementing illness requiring assistance to remain living at home.
<b>Is there a waiting list?</b>	Yes
