Description of Service	<p>The Transitional Aged Care Team provides short-term intervention (up to 12 weeks) for older persons requiring slow stream therapy and / or another service following discharge from a hospital stay.</p> <p>The program is designed to reduce the need for Long-Term Residential Care or hospital for frail, older people with a chronic condition and to enable participants to appropriately enter Residential Care.</p> <p>Transitional Care will provide greater opportunities and resources for the older person to improve their physical functioning and mobility and to regain and maintain their daily living skills.</p>
Who to refer?	Hospital In-patients who are returning to their home and require the opportunity to improve physical functioning and mobility in order to regain daily living skills.
How to refer?	Social Worker or CCC on Ward faxes referral to Southcare.
Referral criteria	A person who is in hospital at the time of referral, but is medically stable and is ready to be discharged, with an ACAT referral for an ACCR for Transitional Care approval.
