Clinical management of adverse events following immunisation

The Children's Hospital at Westmead has a dedicated Immunisation Adverse Events Service.

This service is designed to assist immunisation providers in the management of adverse events following vaccination in both children and adults.

The service includes:

- Phone advice to immunisation providers about adverse events in children and adults by calling 02 9845 1414
- Review of children and adults in a dedicated specialist clinic:
 - Assessment and management of a serious adverse event
 - Discussion with parents who are concerned about vaccines and adverse events
 - Administration of further vaccines under supervision (if indicated)
 - Information to individual providers about adverse events in their patients
 - Outline options for future vaccine schedules
